Club Assembly23rd March

At the next Club Assembly the following will be discussed:

"The current Board has approved the appointment of a Membership and PR Director from 1st July, 2010. This person would focus solely on increasing our membership and be looking for ways we can do that. Examples of this would be to put signs up when we do a working bee in the community so the general public can see what we are about and ensuring media coverage when we donate funds to a good cause.

The new Director would also co-ordinate the appropriate subcommittees.

To make such an appointment we must amend the By-Laws of the Club, specifically Article 2 which currently states that:

"The governing body of this Club shall be the Board consisting of ten (10) members of this Club, namely, four (4) directors elected in accordance with Article 9A, section 1, of the Rules and Constitution of this Club, and the president, president-elect (or president-nominee, if no successor has been elected), secretary, treasurer, immediate past president, and craft fair director."

If approved, Article 2 would read:

"The governing body of this Club shall be the Board consisting of eleven (11) members of this Club, namely, five (5) directors elected in accordance with Article 9A, section 1, of the Rules and Constitution of this Club, and the president, president-elect (or president-nominee, if no successor has been elected), secretary, treasurer, immediate past president, and craft fair director."

The motion to amend the By-Laws will be discussed at the next Club Assembly set for 23rd March, 2010.
