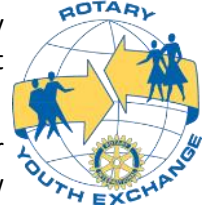

Rotary Tasmania is looking after the parking of Campers and Caravans in the Cow Paddock across the road from the Hotel.

**Setting Up:**

We are setting up the Camping area on Tuesday 21<sup>st</sup> February.

We set up the Marquee, tables and Chairs on Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> February.

We receive campers from Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> through to Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> February.

**Clean Up:**

On Sunday we clean the paddock of rubbish and remove all star pickets and return the paddock to its normal state.

**Friday 24<sup>th</sup> February**

We set up the Raffle Ticket selling marquee and the merchandise selling marquee in Hotel Grounds plus banners etc.

The Raffle has a total of 8 prizes with an estimated value of approximately \$8K. There will be eight draws and tickets will sell for 3 for \$10. There are 10,000 tickets to be sold. We are using Windeward Bound participants to sell tickets on the day plus Rotarians. Both the DG and DGE will be present to sell tickets.

Funds raised will be going to the ROTARY TASMANIA GYNAECOLOGICAL CANCER PROJECT which supports Tasmanian women living with gynaecological cancer.

John Dare will have a list at Tuesday's meeting for people to sign up as volunteers.

Currently there are 5 Tasmanian Rotary Clubs supporting this project.

All volunteers need to sign on and off at the camp entrance and be issued with a wrist band to allow entry into the event.

  - d) Heaters on
  - e) Set up PA System
  - f) Assist with Attendance
- 3. Pack-Up** (assistance from all Rotarians appreciated)
  - a) Everything off tables and back to kitchen
  - b) Pack up PA system
  - c) Remove tablecloths and take home to wash
  - d) Tables and chairs—put away
  - e) Check toilets

This exchange program offers and provides an excellent grounding for further development and experience for talented professionals to broaden their knowledge of their respective careers.

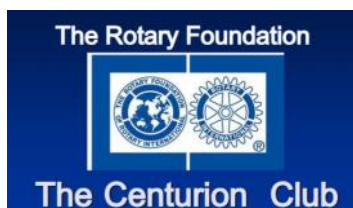
