Since then they have been enjoying many a dram from all over the world and learning what goes into making a great whisky. Convinced that Tasmania has something special to offer the whisky world they started their own independent bottling business in 2016.



AUSTRALIAN ROTARY HEALTH LAURA GRATTIDGE

Stephanie, Andrew, Merrilyn and I attended the Australian Rotary Health function, hosted by the Rotary Club of Launceston, where Laura Grattidge spoke on her PhD that she commenced in 2020 on *Suicide Prevention in Rural Communities*, and will finish towards the end of this year. She gave a detailed description of her study so far and she has recently had a paper



published, 'Exploring Community-Based Suicide Prevention in the Context of Rural Australia: a Qualitative Study'.

About Laura

Laura works at the Centre for Rural Health, University of Tasmania, as a project manager and research assistant, evaluating suicide prevention, mental health and wellbeing programs around Tasmania.

Before working at the Centre for Rural Health around 6 years ago, she worked in project, data and research-related roles, for around 13 years across state and federal government health and welfare organisations in Australia. With a public health and psychology academic background, Laura has interests in public and mental health, suicide prevention, and other complex social issues impacting local communities and vulnerable groups. Laura is focused on conducting research in these areas to influence policy and social change in Australia's regional and rural areas, providing a voice for youth, children, and people affected by mental ill-health and suicide.

Laura is an advocate for people with a lived experience of suicide and mental ill-health, representing Australia and starting a suicide prevention sub-committee within the Global Mental Health Peer Network, and recently being appointed as a lived experience member of the project management group for the MANNA Institute, a virtual institute of researchers working with industry and community partners to improve wellbeing and mental health in regional, rural and remote areas of Australia. She also represents Tasmania on the Tas/Vic Joint Committee at Suicide Prevention Australia.

Laura commenced a PhD in 2020, building on academic and professional experiences to explore the role of communities in rural suicide prevention, and develop 'Best Practice Guidelines for Youth Suicide Prevention in Rural Australian Communities'.
