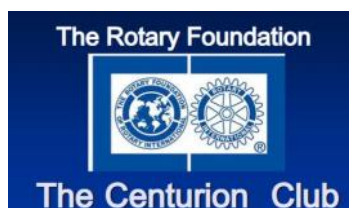

2. if you change your commitment to a roster (either withdrawing or joining) be certain to notify those responsible for the roster as soon as possible.

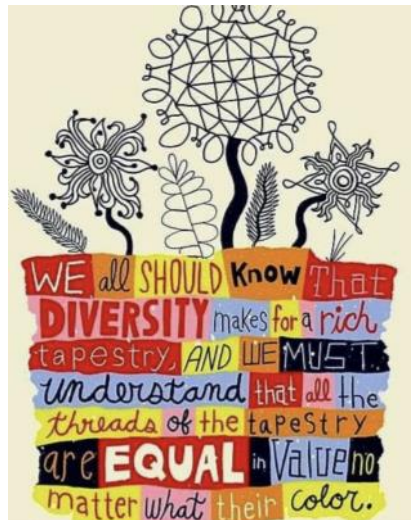
