ROTARY HISTORY

DEVELOPMENT OF OUR CRAFT FAIR:

Over the ensuing years the Craft Fair continued to develop and expand (both increased numbers of exhibitors and attendees).

As the Fair grew it was necessary to find additional accommodation so the fair spread throughout various venues around the town and gallery owners became involved.

Cottage industries blossomed to include cheese, wine, liqueurs, truffles, etc.

The Fair grew to such an extent that it gained recognition as a major Tasmanian event. Publicity for the Fair began to go national and to attract any form of Government assistance.

In 1993 the Rotary Club of Deloraine decided to change the name from the Tasmanian Cottage Industry and Craft Fair (which was a mouthful) to The Tasmanian Craft Fair.

This gave focus to the State in addition to the event. We now refer to the show as The Tasmanian Craft Fair at Deloraine (presented by the Rotary Club of Deloraine. Locals still use the phrase "The Deloraine Craft Fair" affectionately)

SET UP — VOCATIONAL SERVICE

TUESDAY 16TH APRIL

For Rotary:

- 1. Directorate nominated on Roster is responsible for set up and pack up. If not available please arrange own change.
- 2. Set-Up
 - a) Obtain code from Ann 041 111 6480
 - b) Tables into correct position and to set tables with Cutlery,

Rotary Placemats, Salt, Pepper, Serviettes, Water Carafes (Note—tablecloths to be used only for 'special' occasions)

- c) To ensure that glasses are either placed on side table with drinks. Note: Only one bottle of red and one bottle of white to be opened at beginning of night, if more are required these are held at the President's table.
- d) To place on table with urn—mugs, spoons, tea, coffee etc. Ensure urn is turned on
- e) Heaters on (as required)
- f) Set up PA System
- g) Assist with Attendance (check Weekly Duties list)
- **3.** Pack-Up (assistance from all Rotarians appreciated)
 - a) Everything off tables and back to kitchen
 - b) At the end of the night all opened bottles of wine should be removed from the Function Centre
 - c) Pack up PA system
 - d) When tablecloths are used, to take home and wash
 - e) Tables and chairs—put away
 - f) Check toilets
 - g) Lights off, lock up and keys back in box.
