#### **ROTARY PROJECTS**

#### **River Bank**

**1974** Rotary painted the toilets at the Deloraine Bridge.

**1976** onwards Rotary has cleaned up the western side of the River Bank (starting near the road bridge). In **1980** we started working on the footpath along the western bank of the Meander River. **1995** saw Rotary start work on constructing the path on East Parade side of river.

**1978** saw the building of the Rotary Train (now known as Apex Train). It was used along the western footpath, particularly during the Deloraine Fiesta, along the riverbank.

**1982** saw the Rotary Endeavour pontoon floating on the Meander River. In **1983** with the aid of a wire rope the pontoon was used during the Deloraine Fiesta to take passengers back and forth across the Meander River.





- Fundraising guidance will be provided.


#### **HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?**
