ROTARY PROJECTS

River Bank

1974 Rotary painted the toilets at the Deloraine Bridge.

1976 onwards Rotary has cleaned up the western side of the River Bank (starting near the road bridge). In **1980** we started working on the footpath along the western bank of the Meander River. **1995** saw Rotary start work on constructing the path on East Parade side of river.

1978 saw the building of the Rotary Train (now known as Apex Train). It was used along the western footpath, particularly during the Deloraine Fiesta, along the riverbank.

1982 saw the Rotary Endeavour pontoon floating on the Meander River. In **1983** with the aid of a wire rope the pontoon was used during the Deloraine Fiesta to take passengers back and forth across the Meander River.



ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING
